SIMON SCHAMA'S POWER OF ART

- Series Explores Dramatic Turning Points in Lives of Eight Artists and the Masterpieces That Changed the Way the World Looks at Art -

can do beyond the daily grind. It takes us places we had never dreamed of going; it makes us look again at what we had taken for granted.

In 1941, during the Nazi occupation of Paris, the Gestapo visited Pablo Picasso's Left Bank flat, where a member of the secret police spied a postcard of the artist's most famous work, *Guernica*. The giant mural memorialized Germany's 1937 aerial obliteration of a small Basque village. "Was it you who did this?" the Nazi demanded of Picasso, to which he replied, "No. It was you." In the eight-part SIMON SCHAMA'S POWER OF ART, internationally acclaimed scholar and writer Simon Schama recounts that story while challenging viewers with a typically provocative query: "Shouldn't art just stick to what it does best, the delivery of pleasure, and forget about being a paintbrush warrior? Or is it, when the bombs are dropping, that we find out what art is really for?"

SIMON SCHAMA'S POWER OF ART premieres Monday, June 18, 2007, 9:00 p.m. ET on PBS with "Van Gogh," followed by "Picasso" at 10:00 p.m. The series continues on consecutive Mondays, June 25-July 30, 2007, 10:00-11:00 p.m. A television history of the creative moment, the series features eight narratives of embattled heroes confronting disaster and triumph while making art that continues to resonate. Propelled by Schama's passionate storytelling, POWER OF ART melds dramatic re-enactments, location shooting and art photography to create a challenging series that explores the power and, ultimately, the whole point of art. "This is not a series about things that hang on walls; it is not about decor or prettiness," Schama says. "It is a series about the force, the need, the passion of art -- the power of art."

SIMON SCHAMA'S POWER OF ART takes viewers on a sweeping cinematic journey to the turning points in the lives of eight artists and a work that defined the career of each. In broadcast order they are:

* Michelangelo Merisi da Caravaggio (1571-1610) and *David With the Head of Goliath*, Monday, June 25, 10:00pm

* Gian Lorenzo Bernini (1598-1680) and *The Ecstasy of St. Theresa*, Monday, July 2, 10:00pm

* Rembrandt van Rijn (1606-1669) and *The Conspiracy of the Batavians Under Claudius Civilis*, Monday, July 9, 10:00pm

* Jacques-Louis David (1748-1825) and *The Death of Marat*, Monday, July 16, 10:00pm

* J.M.W. Turner (1775-1851) and *Slave Ship (Slavers Throwing Overboard the Dead and Dying, Typhoon Coming On)*, Monday, July 23, 10:00pm

* Mark Rothko (1903-1970) and the Seagram murals. Monday, July 30, 10:00pm
