

Sara Ransford Workshop Supply List

Sharing of resources is recommended

Individuals Items:

- Any clay tools you would like to bring (there are none available at UH)
- Scissors – sturdy, and will get dirty
- Aggregates (used to create texture) – like pearl lite, rice, glass, saw dust, etc
- Fishing line (for hanging object), balloons, burlap, lace, anything you'd like to dip (like a pine cone).
- Apron & your own towel
- Rolling pin
- Cotton string/twine/rope, Sisal yarn, ... any natural fiber.

Shared Items (Some available on site, but suggest bringing these if you have them)

- 5 gallon buckets with lids (plus 1 extra lid to carve a slit into).
- Electric drill (corded with extension cord; extra battery – may need to run a while)
- Clay/glaze mixer (Jiffy mixer style or Paint mixer)
- A colander or strainer with small openings that can sit on the 5 gal. bucket
- 2 – pint sized containers with lids (such as Tupperware container)
- 1 – 2 squirt bottles (like a slip trailer or thicker, like a mustard/ketchup plastic bottle)
