Eligibility & Fees

All artists and/or crafts-person of the State of Hawaii are invited to enter.
The non-refundable entry fee is \$10 per entry, \$5 per entry for Hawaii Craftsmen Members. Any number of pieces may be entered.

Conditions & Display Regulations

No work shown previously in a juried exhibition on Oahu is eligible. All entries must be of original design and created independently within the last two years.

All exhibitors are required to sit the show for a minimum of three hours, find a substitute sitter, or pay \$15. Neighbor island entrants are exempt from sitting or charges.

SIZE & WEIGHT: At the discretion of the exhibition chairperson an entrant, whose work poses an installation or handling problem, may be held responsible for the handling and installation of his/her pieces under the supervision and direction of the exhibition chairperson. If special display stands or installation is requested, an entrant may be required to provide his/ her own.
**All entries must be ready for display (hooks, rods, velcro, wire, etc. attached) with written instructions if hanging method is not obvious.*

LIABILITY: It is understood and agreed that all entries are submitted at the owner's risk. Care will be taken in the handling of all entries, but neither Fiber Hawaii '92 nor the Honolulu Academy of Arts will assume responsibility for the loss or damage to works submitted, no matter how such damage might be sustained.

SALES: A commission of 20% members, 30% non-members will be taken on all sales made at the exhibition.

Pieces sold cannot be taken until the end of the exhibition, **Saturday, October 24, 9am - 4pm**. Accepted pieces must remain at the Academy Art Center at Linekona for the total period of the exhibition and are subject to reproduction for publicity purposes.

Receiving of Entries

OAHU: Deliver to Academy Art Center at Linekona, 111 Victoria Street, mauka entrance, **Saturday, September 26, 9am - 4:30pm**.

NEIGHBOR ISLANDS: Mail entries to Hawaii Craftsmen, P.O. Box 22145, Honolulu, Hawaii 96823, to arrive between **September 22 - 25th**, or air freight with delivery direct to Academy Art Center at Linekona on **September 26, 9am - 4:30pm ONLY**. Enclose a check for return shipping and specify first class, parcel post or air freight and insurance information. Original packing **MUST** be reusable for the return trip.

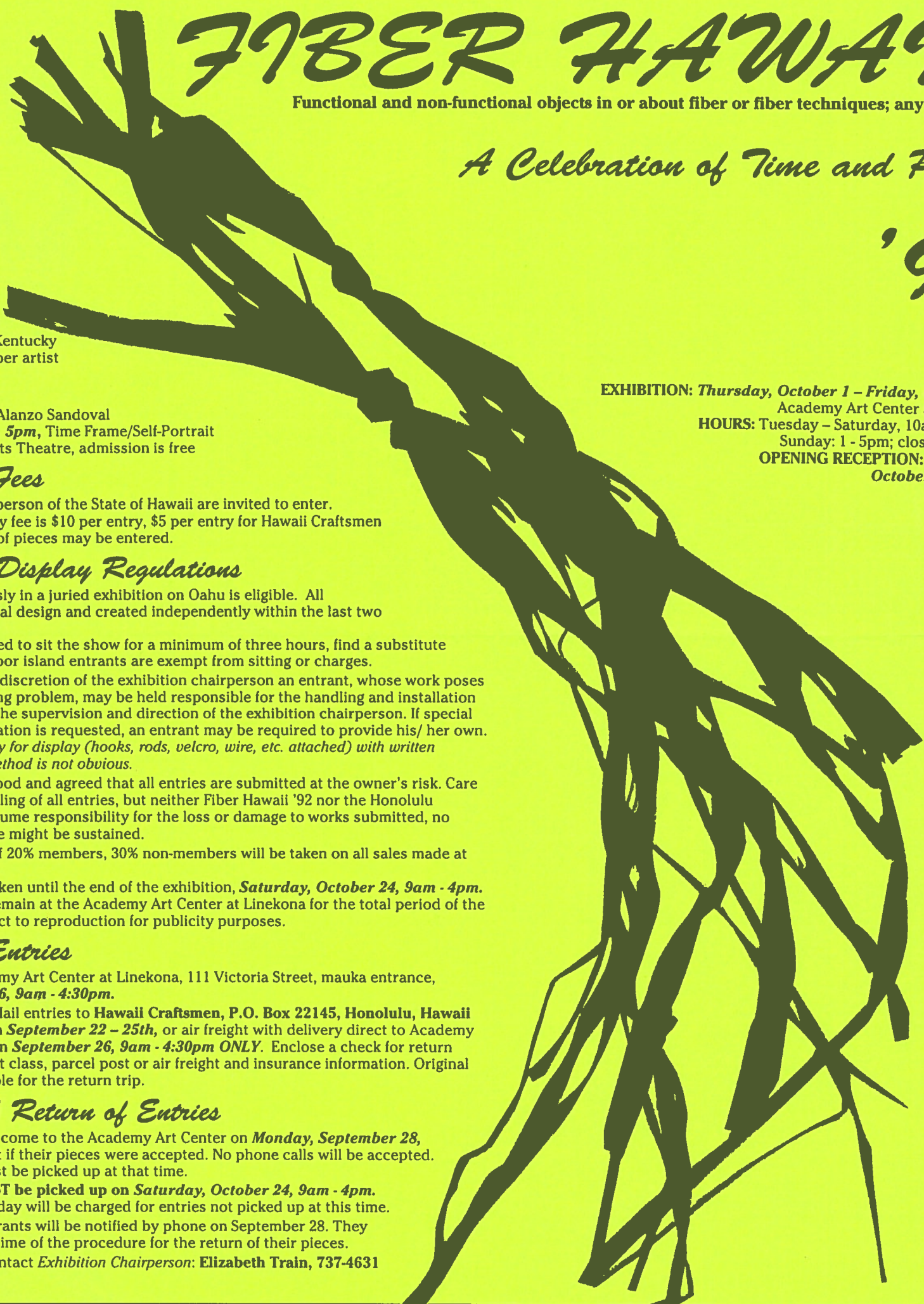
Notification & Return of Entries

OAHU ENTRANTS must come to the Academy Art Center on **Monday, September 28, 9am - 4:30pm** to find out if their pieces were accepted. No phone calls will be accepted. Pieces not accepted must be picked up at that time.

ACCEPTED PIECES MUST be picked up on Saturday, October 24, 9am - 4pm. A penalty fee of \$15 per day will be charged for entries not picked up at this time.

NEIGHBOR ISLAND entrants will be notified by phone on September 28. They will be informed at that time of the procedure for the return of their pieces.


